RCAC was established in 1977, operating under the The Christian & Missionary Alliance – Canadian Pacific District (CPD). We are a multi-generational community, trilingual across five congregations - three Cantonese-speaking, one English speaking, and one Mandarin speaking. About 1000 people in total attend our worship services. The current staff team consists of nine full-time pastoral staff and two administrative staff.

RCAC is located in Richmond, BC, near the community of Steveston. A multi-cultural, upper-middle class residential community with an even mix of local and immigrant families that is considered one of the older areas of Richmond. The general population has a large percentage of Cantonese and Mandarin speaking residents.

- Works together with the Board of Elders as the chairperson.
- Accountable to the Board of Elders and CPD District Superintendent.
