



Notice Regarding Travel Warnings

RWAM's Out-of-Canada Emergency Medical Benefit In Countries Where Travel Warnings Have Been Issued

The Government of Canada's website includes Travel Warnings and Advisories for specific countries experiencing civil unrest. Their website is www.travel.gc.ca and the information is updated regularly. We recommend that you check this website prior to leaving Canada for essential travel information.

When a Travel Warning or Advisory has been issued for a country that you are travelling to, it is important for you to be aware of the impact this may have on your Out-of-Canada Emergency Medical benefit with RWAM.

Although your coverage itself may be allowed, the Emergency Assistance Services listed in your Travel Assist brochure, cannot be guaranteed in countries where there is civil unrest. Also, you may be obliged to pay for any medical services or treatment directly to the provider with your own funds. If this situation occurs, you will need to submit original itemized receipts upon your return to Canada.

Please note that medical treatment rendered as a result of Acts of War or Terrorism is not covered.
